Hawkesbury, June 6, 2018 – The Recreation and Tourism Department of the Town of Hawkesbury is both proud and excited to announce its 2018 summer program. The rec team has once again stepped up efforts to offer a wide range of activities and events, many of which are guaranteed to put a smile on your face!

The Club

For a second season, the Town of Hawkesbury is pleased to bring back the ever-popular park animation program affectionately known as The Club, whose councillors will provide activities in Old Mill and Larocque Parks from Monday to Friday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. As an essential element in the development of neighbourhood life, The Club offers free drop-in activities in the park for youth who do not attend day camp, but who would still like to be active and take part in a variety of activities that will keep them moving. For 4 to 13 year olds, the free activities take place from July 2 to August 24, however, the schedule may be modified due to participation or inclement weather. Note that the youth are invited to participate on a voluntary basis, may come and go as they please, and is not a babysitting service. Registration is not required, so there is really no reason to stay home this summer!
