#### BY-LAW N° 125- 96

# A by-law to establish fees for bicycle licences

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1990, c. M.45, s. 132 requires that all residents in the Municipality owning and using any wheeled vehicle or any class or classes thereof, other than a motor vehicle and a trailer as defined in the <u>Highway Traffic Act</u> and a wheeled vehicle used for farming purposes, to obtain a licence therefor before using it upon any highway of the Municipality.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Hawkesbury enacts as follows:

- 1. No person shall within the limits of the Corporation of the Town of Hawkesbury use or permit the use of any wheeled vehicle, other than a motor vehicle and a trailer as defined in the <u>Highway Traffic Act</u> and a wheeled vehicle used for farming purposes until he has obtained a licence to do so from the Clerk or the Chief of Police.
- No licence shall be issued to an owner or user of a wheeled vehicle as
  defined above unless and until the Clerk or the Chief of Police has been
  provided with the make, description and serial number of the wheeled
  vehicle.
- Every licence shall state the make, description and serial number of the wheeled vehicle as well as the name and address of the owner or user applying for the licence.
- 4. Upon issuance of the licence, the Clerk or the Chief of Police shall provide to the licensee a sticker bearing a number corresponding to the registration.
- 5. Every licensee shall keep the sticker issued pursuant to the previous section affixed on the left hand side of the bicycle's frame in such a position that the number and lettering are plainly visible.
- 6. The licence issued to an owner or user shall not be transferable.
- 7. The fee for such a licence shall be \$5.00.
- 8. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction thereof shall forfeit, and pay a penalty for each such offence and every such penalty shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O., c. P.33 and amendments thereto.

- 10. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of January, 1997.
