Subject: Temporary Closure of Sidewalks, Pedestrian Pathways and Recreational

Lanes for the Winter Period.

Recommendation

Whereas the Town will not be able to provide the winter maintenance services in accordance with Section 16.4 of the Minimum Maintenance Standards for the sidewalks, pedestrian pathways and recreational lanes as listed in this recommendation, and;

Whereas Section 16.8 of the Ontario Regulation 239/02 Minimum Maintenance Standards for Municipal Road (MMS) allows a municipality, pursuant to its powers, to close a highway, a sidewalk, a bicycle lane, all three-asset types or any combination thereof.

Be it resolved that the sidewalks, pedestrian pathways and recreational lanes listed in the recommendation be temporarily closed for the winter period being November 1st of the current year to April 30th of the following year, and that a by-law is adopted as recommended in the document 2019_REC_97.

Explanation, history, context

Section 16.8 of Ontario Regulation 239/02 minimum Maintenance Standards for Municipal Roads (MMS) allows a municipality, pursuant to its powers, to close a highway, the sidewalk, the bicycle lane, all three-asset types or any combination thereof.

The Public Works Department does not provide or will not provide winter maintenance services on certain sections of sidewalks, pedestrian pathways and recreational lanes within the Town of Hawkesbury. Being that the Town is not able to provide the service in accordance with Section 16.4 of the MMS, these sections will remain closed during the winter season.

For the purposes of section 16.8(1), a highway or part of a highway is closed when a municipality passes a by-law to close the highway or part of the highway.

The following sections of sidewalks, pedestrian pathways and recreational lanes within the Town will be closed during the winter season (November 1st of the current year to April 30th of the following year):
